

4. ADHD Assessments

An assessment for Attention Deficit Hyperactivity disorder involves an assessment of a child's behavioral and cognitive functioning.

At Prosper Health Collective a full ADHD assessment for a child or adolescent involves the following:

1. Parent/Child Initial Consultation – 50 minutes
2. Cognitive (IQ) Assessment – 120 minutes
3. Liaison with teachers and other health professionals as required
4. Report Preparation – 90 minutes
5. Parent Feedback Consultation – 30 minutes

Please note:

- A formal diagnosis of ADHD must be made by a medical professional such as a Paediatrician or Neurologist
- Medicare or private health insurance funds typically do not offer a rebate for psychological assessments.
- In situations where previous psychometric testing has been completed, it may not be appropriate to undertake all of the above steps and the price will be adjusted accordingly.
- In some situations further assessment may be required and this will incur additional costs. This will be done in consultation with you.
